What is the Historical Thinking Skill: CCOT?

- The CCOT (Continuities & Changes Over Time) is one of the HTS tested on the APWH Exam. (*Others are Causation & Comparison*)
- Continuity and Change Over Time tests your ability to **note how civilizations and ideas evolve (*what changes*)**, yet remain true to what makes them unique (***what stays the same***).
- The easiest way to plan an essay response to this skill is **create timelines in your head & in your essay booklet**
- Then use the timelines to **trace changes and reasons for change, OR to identify continuities and the reasons for continuity.**
- On the test, this skill covers at least one of the periods in the concept outline. **It can address, for example, any of the course themes, such as technology, trade, culture, migrations, or environment.**
