TYPES OF PROPAGANDA

- **DEMONIZING THE ENEMY**: Instill belief that an opponent is evil and dangerous.
- **BANDWAGON**: Encourages everyone to support a cause.
- **TESTIMONIAL**: Using the words of a famous person to persuade support or non-support of an idea.
- **REPETITIVE (Ad Nauseum)**: words or short slogan used over and over.
- **FLAG-WAVING**: Doing something because it is patriotic.
- **EMOTIONAL**: words that make you feel strongly about someone or something.
- **APPEAL TO FEAR**: instilling anxieties and panic to support or not support an idea.
- **COMMON MAN**: appeal to people's common sense to support or not support an idea.

- **MUST** be neat, use color, & cover the whole paper
 - (*For Final Drafts, you will use ONE poster board cut in two to create TWO posters*)

- Your **OWN** idea! Don't plagiarize! Mrs. Osborn has seen A LOT of propaganda posters.

HELPFUL HINTS

- **Generally, posters are seen in areas where people are just “passing by” (like in the hallways here at RHS)**
- **SO → Focus on the visual message using as few words as possible (You want to get your point across without someone having to stop to examine an overly-detailed image OR read a lot.)**
- **DO NOT use derogatory (negative) imagery/text or violent/inappropriate images (either drawn or printed off the Internet).**
- **WRITE YOUR NAME/CLASS PERIOD ON THE BACK OF YOUR FINAL POSTERS**
