## TYPES OF PROPAGANDA

- <u>DEMONIZING THE ENEMY</u>: Instill belief that an opponent is evil and dangerous.
- BANDWAGON: Encourages everyone to support a cause.
- <u>TESTIMONIAL</u>: Using the words of a famous person to persuade support or non-support of an idea.
- <u>REPETIVE (Ad Nauseum)</u>: words or short slogan used over and over.
- FLAG-WAVING: Doing something because it is patriotic.
- <u>EMOTIONAL</u>: words that make you feel strongly about someone or something.
- <u>APPEAL TO FEAR</u>: instilling anxieties and panic to support or not support an idea.
- <u>COMMON MAN</u>: appeal to people's common sense to support of not support an idea.

## HELPFUL HINTS

- Generally, posters are seen in areas where people are just "passing by" (like in the hallways here at RHS)
- SO → Focus on the visual message using as few words as possible (You want to get your point across without someone having to stop to examine an overly-detailed image OR read a lot.)
- <u>DO NOT</u> use derogatory (negative) imagery/text or violent/inappropriate images (either drawn or printed off the Internet).
- WRITE YOUR NAME/CLASS PERIOD ON THE BACK OF YOUR FINAL POSTERS
